disaster planning

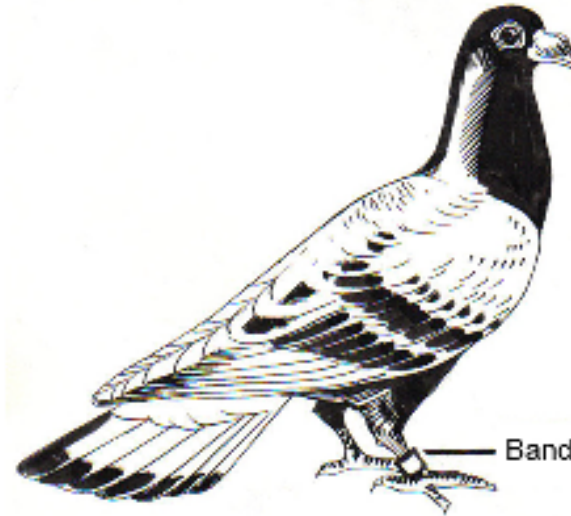
first responses

- liaison with emergency services
(maintain close contact with police, fire brigade etc)
- communication systems initiated
(contact hierarchy, emergency teams etc)
- Health & Safety Controls
- first assessment carried out
- stabilisation procedures
- recovery planning commenced

communication systems

- robust
(can survive the disaster!)
- contact lists
- delegations
- agreed terminology
- single point of contact for external communication

- adequate controls to prevent injury & disease
- adequate safety equipment and training
- expert advice
