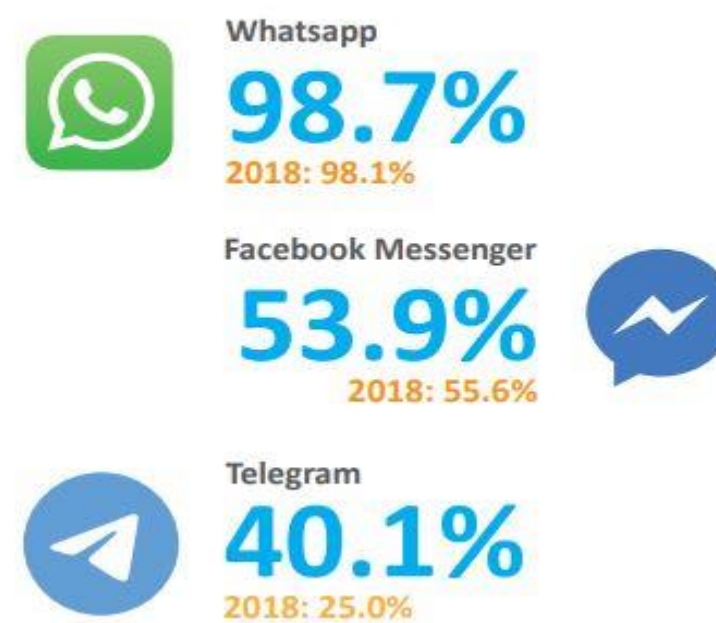

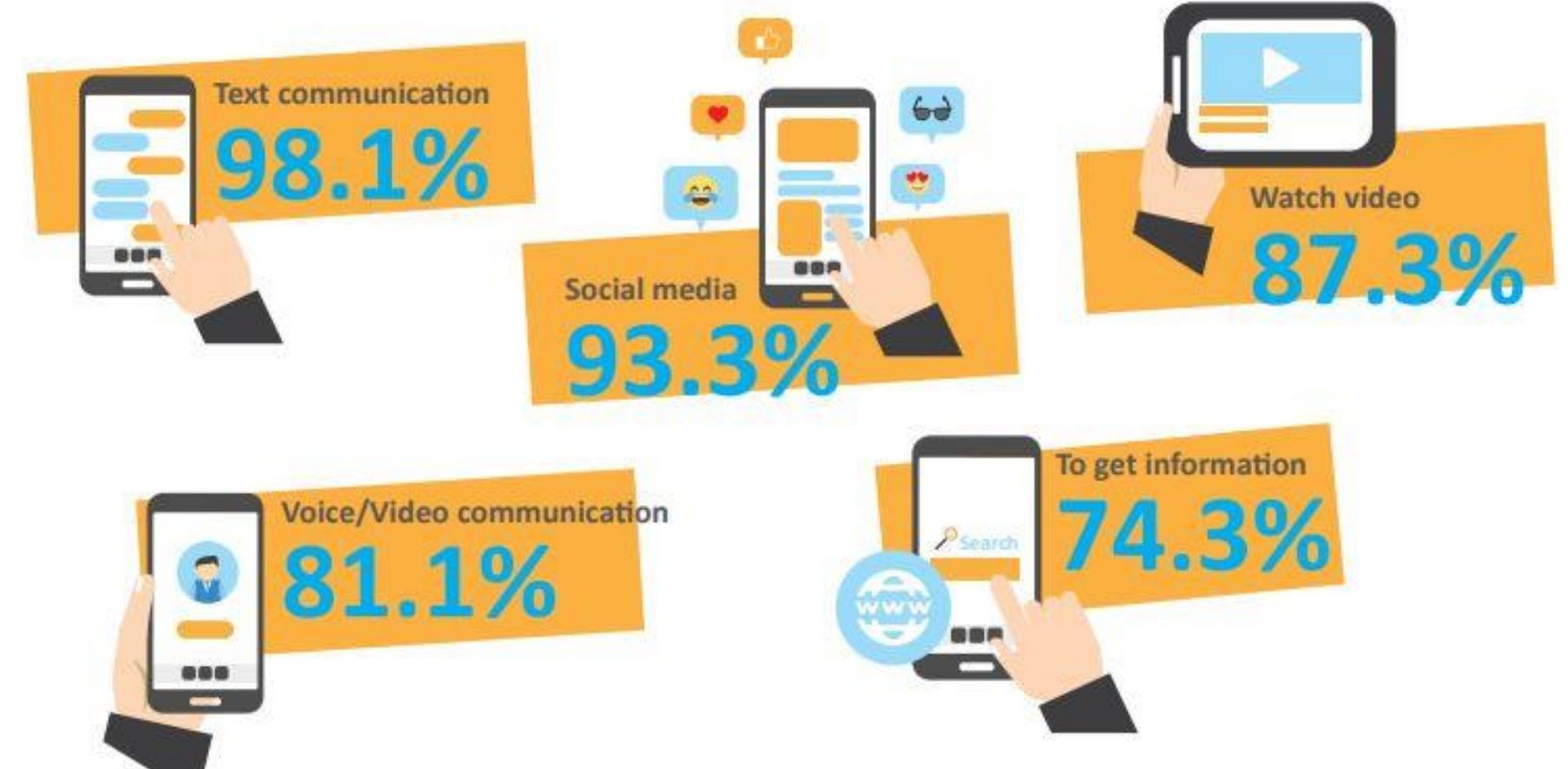

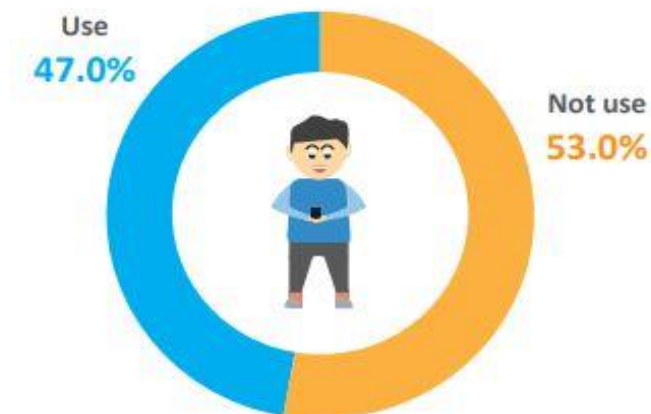

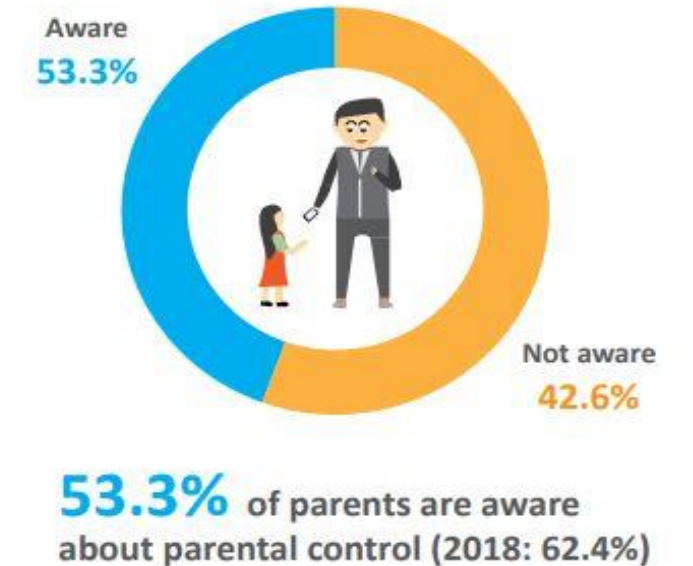

Murder victim had asked for breakup, court heard

GEORGE TOWN: A clerk who was murdered on Valentine's Day three years ago, had told her boyfriend that they could not be together anymore, a High Court here heard.

Psychiatrist Dr Kelvin Lee, 40, from the Bukit Mertajam Hospital, said accused Cheong Teik Keon, 34, told him this during an assessment session at the hospital after Cheong was arrested for the alleged murder of his girlfriend Tan Ching Chin, 24, on Feb 14, 2013.

"His girlfriend had told him on the morning of Valentine's Day on Feb 14, 2013 that they could not be together anymore. He also said that after telling him that, she had rushed off to the bank, which led Cheong to think that she was going to meet another guy.

"He had been depressed since December 2012 after finding out that his girlfriend had been having an affair.

"Cheong also said during the assessment that he found some naked pictures of his girlfriend with another guy on her handphone when he was charging his handphone using his laptop during their trip to Cambodia on Feb 2 and 3, 2013," he said in his testimony yesterday.

Dr Lee was recalled as a witness by the court under Section 425 of the Criminal Procedure Code to testify again in the murder trial of Cheong, an engineer, who was charged with murdering Tan at her family home in Taman Hwa Seng in Alma, Bukit Mertajam, at 8.40am on Feb 14, 2013.

If convicted, Cheong will get the mandatory death sentence under Section 302 of the Penal Code for murder.

On Cheong's mental condition, Dr Lee said he did not display symptoms of hallucination, illusion or dissociation during assessment.

"He can remember exactly that he had stabbed the victim three times and himself, four times. Some are unable to recall but he remembered that he did it.

"He knew that it was wrong but he did not bother about the consequences," he added.

Judicial Commissioner Collin Lawrence Sequerah fixed the case for continued submissions on Aug 25.

DPP Lim Cheah Yit prosecuted the case, while Cheong's counsel is Ramkarpal Singh.

GEORGE TOWN: A consultant forensic therapist who examined Cheong Teik Keon who was charged with killing his girlfriend on Valentine's Day three years ago told the court today that he found him to be insane at the time of the incident.

Datuk Dr Suarn Singh Jasmit Singh said he and his team found that the accused was suffering from a mental illness known as Major Depressive Disorder (MDD).

"The accused was also insane during the incident", he read out his witness statement in front of Judicial Commissioner Collin Lawrence Sequerah.

However Dr Suarn said the accused was eligible to be brought to court to be tried and defend himself.

He said that from his professional opinion, at the time of the incident, Cheong, 34, was of unsound mind and incapable of knowing that his actions were wrong or against the law due to his MDD at the time.

"I am of the opinion that the accused was severely depressed and had impaired judgement and as a result he was incapable of telling right from wrong in the sense that he did not know that his subsequent actions of killing the deceased was wrong or contrary to law", he added.

When being cross-examined by Deputy Public Prosecutor (DPP) Lim Chesh Yit, Dr Suarn said he cannot confirm if the accused was of unsound mind from the date of the incident on Feb 14, 2013 to August 2014 when the accused was brought to him for examination and evaluation.

He also agreed with Lim that he only evaluated the accused only one and a half years later from the date of the incident.

GEORGE TOWN, Sept 29 — Penang-born Cheong Teik Keon, 33, was sentenced to death by the High Court today for murdering his 24-year-old girlfriend Tan Ching Chin in Alma, Bukit Mertajam on Valentine's Day three years ago.

"The court has taken into account evidence by the prosecution and the defence in which the accused had chosen to remain silent in his defence.

"I am unable to find that his mental faculties were so bad that he wasn't aware of the consequences of his actions though the defence had argued a plea of insanity," Judicial Commissioner Colin Lawrence Sequerah said when delivering the verdict.

'Isis Malaysia 69' ugut bom mahkamah

"Kepada mana-mana parti yang lama memerintah, kami anak muda Malaysia dengan ini mengumumkan hasil manipulasi tipu helah selama ini menggunakan demokrasi, kami tidak lagi percaya sistem demokrasi.

"Andalah yang membentuk kami, kami terbentuk hasil dari tangan-tangan anda," ugutnya.

Video memaparkan empat lelaki berbaju hitam dan menutup muka itu turut menegaskan bahawa

perjuangan mereka baru bermula.

"Perjuangan kami baru bermula dan akan pergi jauh, semakin rosak demokrasi, semakin berkembang dan jauh cara kami menentang," katanya.

Inspektor Muhammad Adib Rasol, 33, menyatakan, kedua-dua nama mereka tercatat di dalam 141 dokumen dan 73,439 imej sama ada yang telah dipadam tetapi berjaya ditimbulkan kembali menggunakan perisian khas, atau masih terdapat di dalam komputer riba berkenaan.

Beliau memberitahu, antara lain perkataan mengaitkan aktiviti keganasan yang turut ditemukan di dalam dokumen tersebut adalah jihad/usra, fisisabillah, infak/infag, teknik penyamaran, teknik membuat bom/led, al-Qaeda, mujahidin dan Jamaah Islamiyah.

"Perkataan-perkataan itu dikenalpasti melalui analisis data seperti yang diarahkan oleh pegawai atasan," kata saksi pendakwaan ke-17 itu dalam perbicaraan terhadap Yazid dan pembantu kafeteria, Muhammad Hilmi Hasim yang masing-masing menghadapi dua pertuduhan membabitkan keganasan.

Yazid didakwa menggalakan keganasan bagi memajukan ideologi dengan niat mengugut orang awam di Syria di antara pukul 8.30 dan 10.30 pagi, 1 Ogos dan 20 Oktober 2012 di rumah beralamat DL11, Taman Bukit Ampang, Lorong Mutiara 2, Lembah Jaya, Ampang dekat sini.

Pertuduhan itu dikemukakan mengikut Seksyen 130G(a) Kanun Keseksan yang memperuntukkan hukuman penjara 30 tahun dan denda.

Yazid, 51, turut didakwa menjadi ahli kumpulan Tanzim Al-Qaeda Malaysia di antara 1 Ogos 2012 dan 7 Februari 2013 mengikut Seksyen 130KA Kanun Keseksan yang membawa hukuman penjara seumur hidup dan boleh dikenakan denda.

Muhammad Hilmi, 35, pula dibicarakan atas tuduhan menjadi ahli kumpulan terbabit dan bersubahat dalam menggalakan keganasan bagi memajukan ideologi dengan niat mengugut orang awam di Syria.

Dalam keterangannya, Muhammad Adib juga mengukir selain dokumen dan imej, terdapat beberapa rakaman audio di dalam komputer riba itu tetapi beliau tidak membukanya kerana tidak mendapat arahan daripada pegawai atasannya untuk menganalisis kandungan audio berkenaan.

"Saya ditugaskan untuk menganalisis kandungan dokumen dan imej sahaja," katanya ketika menjawab soalan Timbalan Pendakwa Raya, Shukor Abu Bakar.

Dokumen-dokumen serta imej tersebut turut ditayangkan melalui skrin projektor di mahkamah, Yazid dan Muhammad Hilmi, yang dalam keadaan tangan bergeri dibenarkan untuk keluar dari kandang tertuduh, dan duduk berhampiran skrin berkenaan untuk melihat paparan tersebut dengan lebih dekat.

Witness: 141 terrorism-related documents retrieved

Witness says 10 possible passwords were given to him by the investigating officer.



KUALA LUMPUR: A witness told the High Court here today that he retrieved 141 deleted documents from a laptop, which he analysed based on 10 passwords including the name of an Internal Security Act former detainee.

Police forensic analyst Insp Muhammad Adib Rasol, 33, said the 10 passwords were given to him by investigating officer (IO) Insp Mohd Nur Shakinin Ishak.

He said Mohd Nur had asked him to analyse the laptop and retrieve deleted material and documents related to terrorism activities.

He said the IO had also provided him words such as, 'jihad' or 'usra', 'fisisabillah', 'infak', 'teknik penyamaran', 'teknik membuat bom' or 'IED', 'Al-Qaeda', 'Mujahidin', 'Jamaah Islamiyah' and 'Osama bin Laden'.

"All 141 documents that I retrieved contained passwords given by the IO," he said at the examination-in-chief by deputy public prosecutor Shukor Abu Bakar.

In the dock were former ISA detainee Yazid Sufaat, 51, and cafeteria assistant Muhammad Hilmi Hasim, 35.

Yazid is facing two charges of promoting terrorism to threaten the public in Syria, and being a member of the Tanzim Al-Qaeda Malaysia, while Muhammad Hilmi is accused of abetting him.

They allegedly committed the offence at DL 11, Taman Bukit Ampang, Lorong Mutiara 2, Lembah Jaya, Ampang between August 1, 2012 and February 7, 2013.

Muhammad Adib, who has been working at the Royal Malaysian Police forensic laboratory in Cheras since September 1, 2009, said he retrieved 73,439 photographs that had either been deleted or were still in the system.

The 17th prosecution witness said the laptop was handed to him by assistant analyst Sub Insp Khalid Sokri, 56, at 11 am on November 14, 2012.

Meanwhile, Khalid who is the prosecution's 18th witness said he received the laptop from Mohd Nur at 10.49am on November 14, 2012 before handing it to Muhammad Adib who was at the time attending a meeting.

The two accused were represented by counsel Amer Hamzah Arshad. The trial before justice Mohd Azman Husin continues tomorrow.

"Suspek menggunakan kepakarannya dalam bidang komputer supaya pihak berkuasa tidak dapat menjejaki e-mel yang dikirimnya.

"Wang dimasukkan juga menggunakan akaun dalam Internet, Bitcoin yang sukar dikesan polis," katanya.

Suspek juga dipercayai belajar membuat bom melalui Internet.

"Pemeriksaan di rumah suspek menemui lima lagi bom termasuk satu diletakkan dalam kotak rokok.

"Kami percaya suspek mungkin merancang melakukan serangan yang sama," jelasnya. - Agensi

Bomb threats against Calgary schools demand Bitcoin, police say 'no validity' to threats

Calgary police are investigating after a number of schools across the city received emails last week demanding an online currency known as Bitcoin and threatening to detonate explosive devices at certain schools if the money was not received.

While police have determined the threats are not legitimate, an increased number of police officers are being stationed at the affected schools and letters have been sent home to students and parents.

"We enacted all of our safety protocols. We have enhanced presence of uniform officers at the schools, we'll be doing patrols, the schools will be checked regularly," said Calgary Police Service spokesman Kevin Brookwell on Tuesday.

Brookwell said police received an email on Feb. 5 that made threats against certain Calgary public, private and Catholic schools. Subsequent similar emails were also sent to some of the schools.

"We've determined at this point that there is no validity to these threats," he said.

Miscellaneous - Malaysian police arrest 129 for illegal gambling

Police in Malaysia have arrested 129 people including students for illegal football betting worth 94 million dollars since the World Cup began this month, a police official said Monday.

Mohamad Bakri Zinin, chief of the criminal investigation department, said that since the tournament kicked off in South Africa on June 11 until Sunday police had carried out 156 raids against illegal betting.

Among those arrested were individuals, including a family of four and criminal syndicate members, he told reporters.

"One hundred men and 20 women and nine foreigners were arrested," he said, adding that the youngest bookmaker was 15 years old.



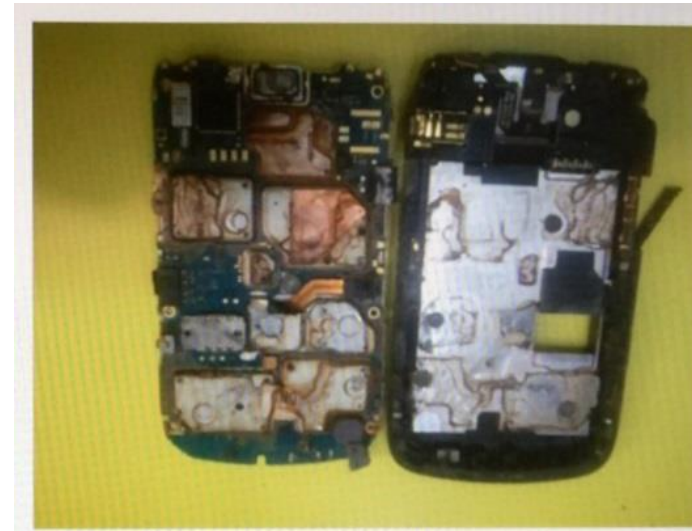

SHAH ALAM: A computer crimes analyst informed the High Court here yesterday that 11 mobile phones which formed a part of the case exhibits in the murder trial of cosmetics millionairess Datuk Sosilawati Lawiya and three other individuals, were sent to him for analysis.

ASP Mohd Zulkifly Mohd Isa, 31, from the Bukit Aman police headquarters said he also received a request to analyse a SIM card, memory card, mobile phone battery and thumbdrive from investigating officer ASP Ishak Yaacob and a police officer named Inspector Suzana.

The 76th prosecution witness said he received the items on Sept 17 and 20 last year.

"Two Blackberry phones (black and white) were given to me in a damp condition with moisture on their screens. After registering them, I used a blower to dry the phones and then locked them up in the mobile phone lab," he said during examination-in-chief by DPP Ishak Mohd Yusoff.

Trader sentenced to death for murder of Stephanie Foray

KUANTAN: The High Court today sentenced a Pulau Tioman trader to death after finding him guilty of the murder of a French woman tourist on the island three years ago.

Judge Datuk Seri Mariana Yahya passed the sentence on Asni Omar, 39, of Kampung Tekek, who was found guilty of the murder of Stephanie Foray, 30, at a house in Kampung Tekek between 8 pm on May 10 and noon on May 12, 2011.

The charge faced by Asni under Section 302 of the Penal Code provides for the mandatory death sentence upon conviction. Mariana said Asni's excuses and explanations during the trial were mere denials and the evidence adduced during his defence indicated that he was the last person to have been with Foray on May 10, 2011.

She said Asni had knowledge of the directional guide he had provided on Aug 8, 2011, to a nearby cave where Foray's body had been hidden and that he had known of her death.

"There is no doubt about the involvement of the accused (Asni) in this case as the victim's (Foray's) belongings were found in a room in his house and blood found splattered on a wall was the victim's as confirmed by the Chemistry Department.

"The court finds that the evidence adduced by the accused is a cooked-up story to show that he is not guilty, but the testimony only weakened the case for the defence," she said.

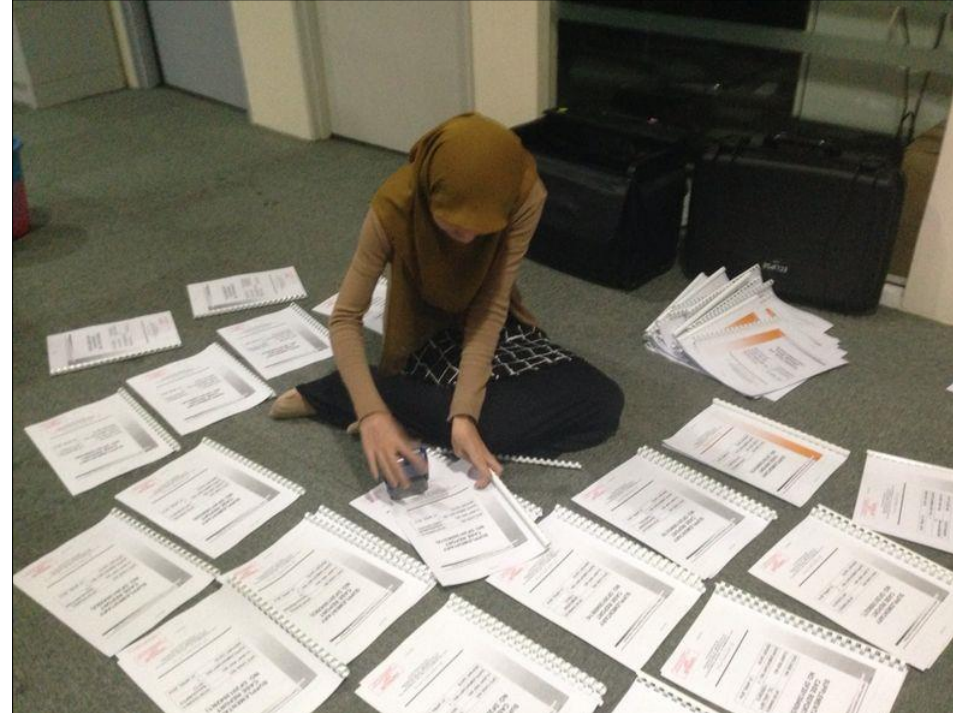

FBI analisis simulator

Biro Siasatan Persekutuan (FBI) secara rasmi menyertai siasatan kehilangan pesawat MH370 dan dijangka mula menganalisis komputer dan simulator yang diambil dari rumah Kapten Zaharie Ahmad Shah, minggu ini.

Justeru, polis dengan bekerjasama dengan CyberSecurity Malaysia, Penerbangan Malaysia (MAS) dan pakar luar negara sedang berusaha mendapatkan semula data serta maklumat yang dipadamkan serta maklumat lain dalam simulator.

Teliti log data

"Mereka sedang meneliti log data yang dipadamkan daripada simulator yang diambil dari rumah Zaharie pada Ahad lalu," katanya pada si-

dang media semalam.

Khalid juga berkata, siasatan mendapati simulator berkenaan mempunyai tiga permainan penerbangan, iaitu Flight Simulator X, Flight Simulator Nine dan Flight Simulator X Plane 10.

"Pakar kita sedang menelitinya. Tetapi, apa yang penting, semua ahli keluarga juruterbang dan pembantunya memberikan kerjasama penuh dalam siasatan," katanya.

Khalid juga menegaskan, semua penumpang, juruterbang dan kru MH370 tidak boleh dikaitkan dalam kehilangan itu sehingga dibuktikan.

Beliau turut meminta semua pihak tidak membuat sebarang spekulasi yang mungkin menyukarkan keluarga penumpang MH370 yang mengharungi tempoh amat mencabar tanpa sebarang khabar berita selepas 12 hari pesawat itu hilang.
